# A FEW ITEMS OF INTEREST VOTE 2023 DOJ INVESTIGATION

The next election day is Tuesday, November 7th. Voters will have the opportunity to cast their votes for positions that include local school boards, city alderman, and mayor.

Typically, voter turnout for these types of elections is light, but these elected positions have the ability to impact many decisions.

To prepare for the election, follow these steps:

- Find out who is on the ballot by visiting the county auditor's website.
- Research which candidates support the things important to you.
- Make sure you are registered to vote.
- Exercise your option to vote early at the auditor's office or some local libraries.
- Plan to vote on November 7th between
   7 a.m. and 8 p.m. at your polling place.

#### **IOWA MEDICAID**

lowa Medicaid launched a new Iowa Medicaid Dashboard earlier this year that has a lot of interesting information about HCBS services in the state.

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has been involved in an investigation at the Glenwood Resource Center. Nearly one year ago, the DOJ secured a settlement with the State of Iowa. That agreement required the state to move residents to new homes with adequate supervision and support. The state was given three years to accomplish this transition. Although a few residents remain at Glenwood, most have found new living arrangements.

The second part of the investigation deals with allegations that the state did not provide lowans with disabilities meaningful choices that provided an opportunity to be served in the community. The lowa Department of Health and Human Services is in negotiations with the DOJ to address those issues.


