#### CHANGES IN THE STATE OF THINGS

Earlier this year, legislation was passed that implements a new behavioral health services system. in Iowa. Currently, Iowa has mental health and disability services regions. Beginning July 1, 2025, those regions will be replaced with fewer districts that include more counties per district. The other change from this redesign is the move of disability services to the Department of Aging and Disability Services.

Most individuals served at Empowering Abilities are on a waiver, as opposed to being funded by the county. For those individuals on the waivers, this is a nonissue. However, for individuals who are county funded, their county funded is uncertain.

County funding has historically been accessed for people who are not on waiver services for a few different reasons. Some of the most common reasons are: they have applied for the waiver and are on the waiting list, which could be as long as seven years, or they don't qualify for a waiver due to their primary diagnosis.

At Empowering Abilities, about 7 to 10 people could be impacted from this change. Because there is a at commitment at Empowering Abilities to continue to service these folks, plans are being made to find a way to fund their services.

The state still needs to work out eligibility requirements and funding processes, so the extent to which these folks are affected is to be determined.
